### Highway Repairs – We all need to get involved

Cornwall Council is responsible for over 7272 kilometres (4545 miles) of road from major principal roads to narrow country lanes – **This includes repairing potholes!!**

Cornwall Council rely on us to report problems on the highways, these are the ways to do it:

Remember to make a note of the reference number you will receive, this is particularly useful should you need to make enquiries about the repair

You may be asked to give an estimate of the surface area of the pothole and its depth - the need to report a pothole is more important than putting yourself in danger checking these details.
